

Resolution No. 20 – 24

WHEREAS, COVID-19 has been declared by the World Health Organization and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention a “public health emergency of international concern”; and

WHEREAS, both the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and Montgomery County have declared a state of emergency due to the identification of COVID-19 infected citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501(b) of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S.A. 7101 et seq., Board of Commissioners Vice-President Clay D. McQueen declared the existence of a public health local disaster emergency in Lower Moreland Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania on Friday, March 13, 2020; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners now desires to extend the initial declaration of March 13, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Lower Moreland Township extends the public health local disaster emergency declaration by an additional sixty days or whenever Governor Wolf ends the state of emergency, whichever is later.

ADOPTED as a resolution by the Board of Commissioners of Lower Moreland Township this 20th day of March, 2020.


