The monthly expenditure activities report is enclosed for your review and approval consideration. Items to highlight from the January expenditure activities and the February bill list for approval are the following:

Credit Card Statement ending Feb, 2024:

- Most charges are recurring monthly charges for utilities, subscription, and IT services.
- There are several training and membership renewal charges as we enter the new year.
- Supplies needed for the MLK Day of Service are included.
- Charges related to 2023 year-end tax filing and supplies are reflected in this list.
- There are several charges related to the recognition of the retirement of Bob Schadegg and Holly Halota.

Feb 2 and Feb 16 Payroll:

- Overtime expenditures for each department as of Feb. 2024 (16.7% of the calendar year) are the following:
 - o Police: 14% of annual budgeted expenditure
 - o Public Works: 9% of annual budgeted expenditure
 - o Snow: 26% of annual budgeted expenditure
 - o Sewer: 15% of annual budgeted expenditure

Most of the check batches issued with payroll include utilities, personnel/contract requirements, loans, staff reimbursements and other time sensitive payments. Non-routine payments include the following:

Feb 2 and Feb 7 Checks issued:

• Feb 7 postage check for the newsletter distribution is due on the day that the newsletter is dropped off at the post office and the amount unknown until everything is weighted. Therefore the check is issued on a date that does not fall on a payroll check date.

Feb 16 and Feb 26 Checks issued:

- Due to account mix up at Fishers Ace Hardware, several past due invoices to Fishers Ace Hardware was paid to get the account balanced and in good standing.
- The vehicle lease initial payment to TD Bank was re-issued on Feb 26 (original

voided) due to the original check having been lost and never reached the bank.

March Bill List: (items to highlight):

- McDonald's Uniform: With the police promotions, new uniform orders were larger than usual
- Township real estate taxes are due for three properties that the Township owns, but are reimbursed by the lessees of those properties.
